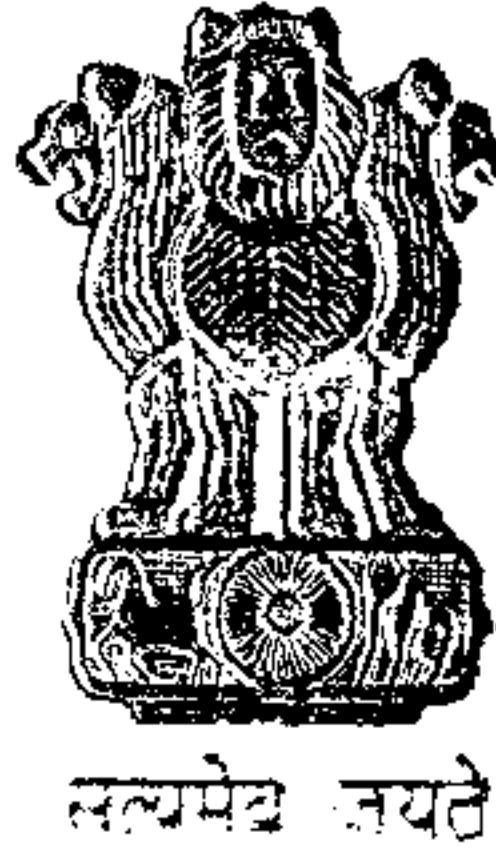

Subject: **Focus on inclusion of convergence projects in MGNREGA Labour Budget 2014-15**

I seek to draw your attention to the following issues pertaining to the implementation of MGNREGA in your State:

2. As you know, the exercise for formulation of Labour Budget for 2014-15 needs to be completed by the end of December this year. This process which involves participatory planning with a bottom-up approach, must be going on currently in the field.

3. The Ministry has issued ten guidelines on convergence in association with various Ministries/Departments from time to time. You may review the status of implementation of all convergence guidelines. Through convergence of MGNREGA with other programmes/schemes, we will be able to attain more effectively the objective of creation of durable assets and strengthening the livelihood resource base of the poor.

1 MGNREGA-NBA convergence for Individual Household Toilets (IHHLs) ought to be accorded top priority.

4.2 The State may decide to adopt targeted approach in terms of **plantation of appropriate species of trees** under MGNREGA along PMGSY roads. The Ministry vide its letter # J-11017/40/2011-MGNREGA (UN) dated 10th September, 2012 had circulated a model on road side plantations under MGNREGA in Muzaffarpur district of Bihar. It may be considered for adoption with necessary customization.

4.3 The Ministry of Rural Development and Ministry of Textiles have recently circulated convergence guidelines for **sericulture plantation** in relevant States. You may kindly advise both the Administrative Departments for special focus on achieving the goals of sericulture plantation laid down in the guidelines.

5. I request you to kindly instruct the field functionaries to formulate the Labour Budget 2014-15 incorporating a large number of convergence projects, particularly those mentioned above.

Sub: Framework for "Planning for works and preparation of Labour Budget" under Mahatma Gandhi NREGA for the FY 2014-15.

Madam/Sir,

Sub-section 6 of Section 14 of the MGNREG Act 2005 mandates that the District Programme Coordinator (DPC) under MGNREGA shall prepare, in the month of December every year, a Labour Budget (LB) for the next financial year containing the details of anticipated demand for unskilled manual work in the district and the plan for engagement of workers in the works covered under the programme. The LB is to be prepared in a bottom up approach by each Gram Panchayat (GP) which should be approved by the respective Gram Sabha (GS). Similarly, the Chapter 6 Mahatma Gandhi NREGA Operational Guidelines, 2013 detailed about the procedure to be followed in planning for works and preparation of LB (*Annexure I*).

2. With a view to ensuring effective execution and to fulfill the desired objectives of MGNREGA, the State/UTs should ensure that while planning for works;
- the works on the land of Scheduled Castes (SCs) and Scheduled Tribes (STs) households should be given priority and special efforts should be made to provide full 100 days of employment to SC/ST households;
 - convergence with NRLM, IWMP, NHM etc., should be encouraged for promoting sustainable livelihood through the creation of productive assets;
 - special efforts should be taken to ensure full convergence with NBA, in view of the policy priority given in sanitation.
 - all the Gram Panchayts (GPs) should have the shelf of projects at least two times the expected labour demand
 - the expected outcomes from executing each work should be estimated and
 - while preparing LB, it should be ensured that all the columns and rows in MIS (NREGASoft) are duly filled in, especially, month-wise projection of labour demand during FY 2014-15.

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3. LB is an essential annual work plan document that entails planning, approval, funding and project execution modalities. Since the LBs are prepared in accordance with the provisions made in sections 13 to 16 of MGNREGA, the DPC has to ensure a strict adherence to the principle of bottom-up approach from planning to approval of the selected shelf of projects by each of the gram sabha in village panchayats of the district. Further, proceedings of each Gram Sabha in which respective LB and the shelf of projects have been approved have to be uploaded as an attachment to the respective LB in the MIS. The State Government is also required to furnish a certificate to the effect that the provisions made in the MGNREGA for preparation of LB have been satisfied and a bottom-up approach has been adhered to in the preparation of LB for 2014-15.

4. You are therefore requested to ensure the above broad framework, in the process of preparation and approval of MGNREGA Annual Plan for the FY 2014-15.
