

Sir,

It has come to the notice of the Government that proposals are being forwarded to the District Programme Coordinators for sanction of pre-cast interlocking tiles/blocks without ensuring 40% cap in material head by the concerned Gram Panchayats and without dovetailing the excess amount from other schemes. This is very soon likely to result in adverse labour material ratio in the implementation of the scheme. It is also likely to result in violation of Para 9 of the Schedule-I of the NREG Act causing huge burden on the State Exchequer, as the Central Government does not provide funds for such excess expenditure.

Please take due care while sanctioning these material intensive works so as to ensure compliance of the Mahatma Gandhi NREG Act, 2005.


