**Subjects: Works taken up under Mahatma Gandhi NREGA**

Sir,

State Governments undertake permissible works under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act for execution. From the information received from State Governments it is seen that not more than 50 per cent of works taken up are completed since the inception of the Mahatma Gandhi NREGA. Recently, Parliamentary Standing Committee on Rural Development has taken a serious view of this. Accordingly, the matter has been considered in the Ministry and in order to ensure timely completion works, the following instructions are issued for strict compliance.


- (a) While obtaining the technical and administration sanction for the works, timeframe for completion of the works should also be indicated;
- (b) Local Vigilance and Monitoring Committee should be constituted for each work. The Committee so constituted shall be responsible for constant monitoring of works at different stages and its completion as per time frame indicated;
- (c) Wherever it is not possible for complete the works within the given time frame, the reasons should be recorded by the implementing agencies and communicated to the State Government which in turn will reflect the same the same in the monthly progress report.
- (d) Top most priority should be given to complete the pending works before taking up the new works;
- (e) While submitting the proposal for labour budget, the progress of works taken up and completed should also be indicated and wherever the works could not be

completed in time, detailed justification along with the remedial measures proposed to complete the works should also be indicated in the labour budget proposal.

2. Non compliance with the above instructions will be viewed seriously. You are accordingly requested to take necessary action and inform the progress made in completing the uncompleted works from time to time.
